SJK(C) Mun Choong is a primary school located in Pangkalan, about five miles north of Kuala Lumpur, with approximately 1,700 students.

The school choir, established in the 1980s, comprises students from Year 3 to Year 6, with 35–50 members annually.

Supported by the school management, professional choir coaches conduct regular training sessions, and all members undergo yearly auditions.

The students are passionate about singing and actively participate in all choral activities.

The choir has achieved notable success both locally and internationally.

In 2023, they won a Gold Medal at the Singapore International Choral Festival and a Silver Medal at the Taipei International Choir Competition in 2024. In 2025, they achieved a Gold Medal in the Children's Championship at the Bali International Choir Festival, became Category Champion at the Malaysian Choral Eisteddfod, and were named a Grand Prix Finalist as well as the Most Outstanding Malaysian Choir.

They have performed

with the Xalapa Symphony Orchestra and other artistic groups from the same university. Choral practice is part of a comprehensive education within the institution, which also includes learning an instrument, music theory, and music history.

The repertoire we usually work on includes classical works from choral literature as well as recently created pieces from various genres and traditional Mexican music.
