



«Jean Sibelius is one of those composers who express the character of the Finnish people by their music truthfully and effortlessly», wrote the critic K. Flodin about the remarkable Finnish composer in 1891. The creativity of Sibelius is not only a bright page in the history of the music culture of Finland, but his popularity as a composer has reached far beyond his native land. His most prosperous creative period was between the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century — a time of growing national liberation and revolutionary movements in Finland. At the time, the small state was a part of the Russian Empire and tested by the moods of an epoch of

social changes preceding a storm. It is remarkable that in Finland, as well as in Russia, this period created a significant rise in the growth of nationalistic art. Sibelius composed in various genres. He wrote seven symphonies, symphonic poems, three orchestral suites, a concert for a violin with an orchestra, two string quartets, piano quintets and trios, chamber vocal and instrumental works, music and drama performances, but his greatest talent lay in symphonic music. In Finland Sibelius played and plays an important role: he is recognized as the quintessential national composer, a symbol of greatness of the country. During his lifetime Sibelius received honours rendered to few artists. There are streets, parks and an annual music festival named after him, and the music institute he studied in was renamed as the Sibelius Academy. It is because of this that the City of Turku, which houses the Sibelius Museum, is a perfect place to organize this international competition of choruses, instrumental music and academic vocal.



Pichamon Mookmaneekun


Bangkok, Thailand

Being in Catholic schooling for 12 years, Pichamon was indoctrinated with a deep appreciation for music, leading to her enthusiastic participation in the choir singing as well as a soloist, and joining competitions during her primary and secondary schoolings. In December 2019, she was admitted to the undergraduate program in Classical Vocal Performance at College of Music, Mahidol University. During her vocal studies, Pichamon has won several prizes in competitions. She was the finalist of the 22nd and 23rd Osaka Int-I Music Competitions in University Voice category, and Duo Ensemble category. In 2021 Pichamon was the 1st prize Winner of Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music Voice Competition in both Art Song, and Opera Ensemble (Duet) categories, a Gold prize winner of Cambridge Music Competition in Advanced Age division, and the 2nd prize Winner of Young Artist Music Contest in University Voice category in Thailand. In performance, Pichamon also had the opportunities to perform as Fiordiligi in Mozart's Cosi fan tutte in "Opera Gala Concert" with Classical Voice Department, a special concert in "The Badminton World Federation" with the Mahidol Symphony Orchestra, and a performance with the Swiss guitarist Christoph Denoth in Thailand, and repeated the concert in Penang, Malaysia. In March 2023, she performed the role as Fiordiligi in Mozart's opera "Cosi fan tutte" with Classical Voice Department. 
